**The World Book Encyclopedia**: 2002, 2003, & 2004. Use the index in volume 22 to help you find your information.

(Location: Fifth shelf and between OPAC computers)

### 2. REF 509.2 BIO

**Biographical Encyclopedia of SCIENTISTS**: Use the index in volume 5. Information is organized by the scientist's last name. (Location: Reference Room)

### 3. REF 510.92 BIO

**Biographical Encyclopedia of MATHEMATICIANS**: The index is in volume.  
(Location: Reference Room)

### 4. REF 909 PRO

#### **Profiles in World History**

Most of the information you seek is found in volumes 3 & 4. Use the index in the back of each volume. (Location: Reference Room)

### 5. REF 920.003 ENC

#### **Encyclopedia of World Biography**

Presents brief biographical sketches that provide vital statistics as well as information on the importance of the person listed. Information is organized alphabetically. (Location: Reference Room)

### 6. REF 920.02 PEA

#### **Explorers & Discoverers**

Use both the alphabetical "Content" page at the front of each book and the "index" at the back of the book to locate the information you need.  
(Location: Reference Room)

### 7. REF 910 EXP

#### **EXPLORERS AND EXPLORATION**

Provides information on explorers -- arranged alphabetically -- Index in vol. 11.  
(Location: Reference Room)

### 8. REF 940 REN

#### **Renaissance & Reformation Biographies – Vols. 1 & 2**

Excellent biographies on many key figures involved in the Renaissance and Reformation.  
(Location: Reference Room)

#### **Biographies**

**1. STUDENT RESOURCE CENTER JUNIOR –**

- a. Enter password: “fres\_log”

At least one link containing an article on your person will now be displayed. Click on one of them. If more than one appears, click on the one that has the name of your person prominently displayed.

- a. Click on the tab that says “grades 5 and above.” Enter your search term. You will be offered encyclopedia articles, reference books, and magazine articles. Also, take note of the additional websites to which you are referred.

- a. Click on “Articles and Databases”
- b. Next to “Biography Resource Center” – Click on “outside of the library”
- c. Enter your Fresno County Library Barcode without any spaces.
- d. Enter the last name of your person, click on “start of last name” button
- e. Click the “Search” button
- f. Next, click on one of the articles about your person.
